Grade Levels: 9, 10, 11, 12

Prerequisite Courses: Sewing I

Course Description:

This course builds on Sewing I course skills and helps students learn zipper and button/buttonhole applications that are incorporated into accessory projects.

Sewing 2 Course Standards

As a result of their participation in this course, students will:

- Analyze social, psychological economic, and cultural factors affecting textile and apparel decisions for individuals and families throughout the life cycle, and how those decisions impact society.
- Evaluate the impact of science and technology on apparel and textiles.
- Analyze how knowledge and skills related to textiles and apparel affect the well-being of individuals, families, and society.
- Enable students to enhance their present sewing skills and to provide additional projects, which will challenge them in reading patterns and applying their creativity.
